The Multi-lingual Interpretation Center for schools with an admission quota for foreign students living in Tokyo opened to ensure smooth communication between parents and schools.

Please use this service when you need to contact teachers or a school management and planning office urgently but are unable to communicate in Japanese.

How to use:

- 1.Call the multi-lingual interpretation center.
- 2.Tell your language to an operator.
- 3.Tell the name of the school where you want to be connected to the operator.
- 4.A Parent, operator and school will be connected and can talk on the same line. Talk what you want to tell to the school, and then the operator will interpret it to the school.

When to use (examples):

- When you have something to consult about your child urgently, but are unable to explain it in Japanese.
- When you want to know what is written in the letter from school because you don't know how to read Japanese.

Note: This service is aimed at connecting parents to schools.

Please understand that it is impossible to connect the line to places other than schools or use the interpretation service in the situation unrelated to school.
